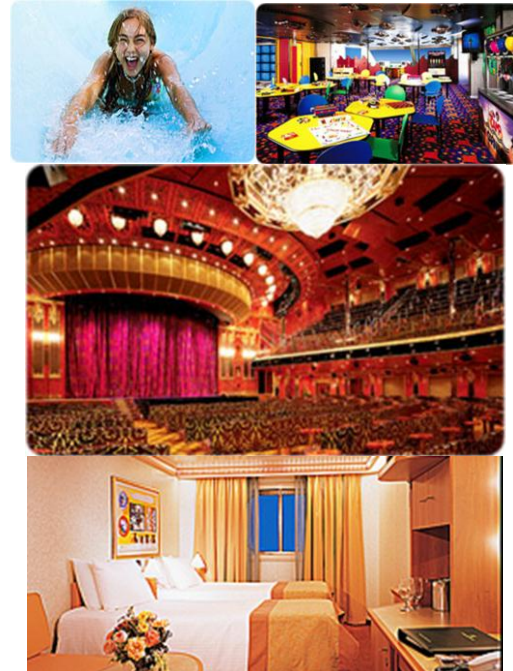

Carnival Glory offers several different room types to accommodate our travel need. They range from Interior rooms, Ocean view and rooms with Balcony.

We have guaranteed rates for the first and second person, starting at

- Interior- \$315.00
- Ocean View- \$370.00
- Balcony- \$445.00.

Taxes per person will be an additional \$175.00 per person.

3rd and 4th person rates start at \$190.00 per person, plus \$175.00 in taxes per person.



However, 3rd and 4th person rates may fluctuate by a few Dollars depending upon the availability. Food, conference hall & entertainment are all included in this price. Food is available 24 hours a day throughout sailing. We have blocked a limited number of rooms, which will be available on a first come first served basis. Once the blocked cabins are gone, these rates cannot be guaranteed. These rates are available until Feb 27th, 2011.

Children under the age of 6 months are not allowed on the Cruise. Rates are the same for kids & adults

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Most dining and onboard activities are included in the price of the cruise. A gratuity of \$10 per day/ per person is automatically added to the credit card you are required to provide when entering the ship.

There will be onetime \$25.00 registration fees per family.

If people prefer to drive in and park their

car, there is convenient parking at the Manhattan Cruise terminal located at 55th street and west side. The daily charge for parking is \$30.00.

Very Important- Since this is considered international travel, all American Citizens must have a valid passport and non-citizens must have Visa/ Green card to board the Ship.
